Consider donating gently-used items to local charities, rather than disposing of them. **Please complete the form** on the back of this page prior to the event and bring it, along with your items, to the Elk River Maintenance Facility.

Eligibility requirements for items to be accepted:

- Most items are priced individually including carpet, mattresses, appliances and electronics
- Mixed trash does not include any other listed items (electronics, mattresses, carpet, etc.)
- Liquids and fluids must be drained from all items
- Load your vehicle with electronics, lights and appliances first, then mattresses, carpet and trash
- Plan to unload your own items
- Items not listed on the form must be approved prior to the event by calling 763.635.1068
- Your form and items will be reviewed by gate staff, who will determine the total cost for item disposal

Materials not eligible or accepted:

Curbside recyclables

Construction and demolition debris

Oil, oil containers (accepted at Compost Site)

Pesticides/Herbicides/Insecticides

Paint/Stains/Solvents

Hazardous or medical waste

Commercial/Business accounts

(excluding document destruction)

Payment: Pay by **cash, credit card or checks** (made out to the City of Elk River). Please have payment ready before you arrive, leave the amount blank on check.
